Under the School Education Act 1999 schools are required to communicate to parents the expected level of Contributions and Charges that will be requested for the new school year. Below is a summary of each of the 5 components for 2019:

1. CONTRIBUTIONS

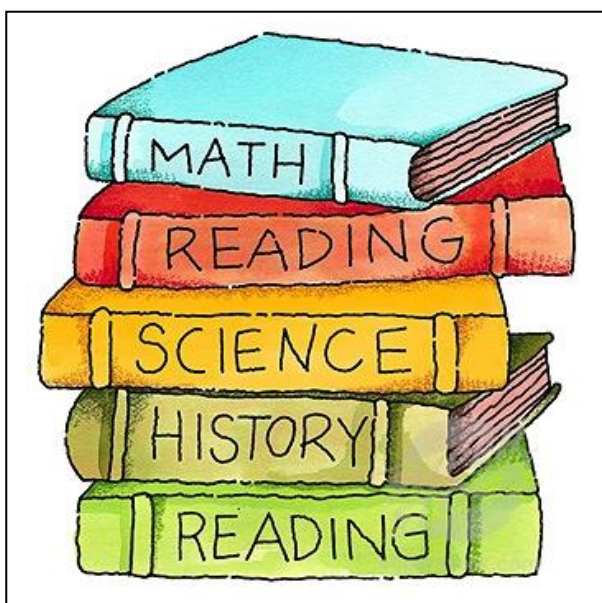
Schools can ask for a voluntary contribution of up to \$60.00 per child. At Warriapendi Primary School an amount of \$60.00 has been set for Kindergarten and Pre-Primary students and \$55.00 for students in Years 1 - 6. Money collected from the voluntary contribution will supplement school expenditure as detailed below. Payment can be made in cash, EFTPOS or by direct transfer.

3. PERSONAL ITEMS LIST - ITEMS FOR PERSONAL USE IN THE EDUCATION PROGRAMME

The costs for these items vary from student to student. The requirements for each student are contained in the year level personal items lists and include stationery. Parents can utilise the personal items list ordering system through Campion or purchase from their store of choice. Payment is made to Campion.

4. OTHER FUNDRAISING COSTS

The P & C will conduct their own fundraising in 2019. Every parent will be given the option of participating in fundraising. In 2018 the P&C conducted fundraising through the canteen and other various product promotions; sausage sizzles, stalls, raffles and other.

5. OPTIONAL COSTS FOR NON-EDUCATIONAL COMPONENTS

All schools, including ours, offer services that incur costs but are not directly related to education costs. These may be directly through the school or by way of the P&C or outside organisations. Examples of these costs include: school photos, vacation swimming, book fairs, free dress days and charitable fund raising activities.

Parents need to be aware that costs of this nature may arise and have not been included in this notification of Contribution and Charges for 2019.

Finally, the Contributions and Charges have been kept to a minimum but do acknowledge the importance of parents contributing to ensure the learning environment is enhanced for all children at Warriapendi Primary School.

GENERAL INFORMATION FROM THE PRINCIPAL

The School Board has ratified school Contributions and Charges to ensure compliance with the School Education Act 1999.

The voluntary contribution requested by the Warriapendi Primary School Board for 2019 is \$55 for students in Year 1 to Year 6 and \$60 for Kindergarten and Pre-primary.

This contribution will supplement school budget allocations and allow teachers to purchase a wider range of quality resources to support and develop quality student learning outcomes.
